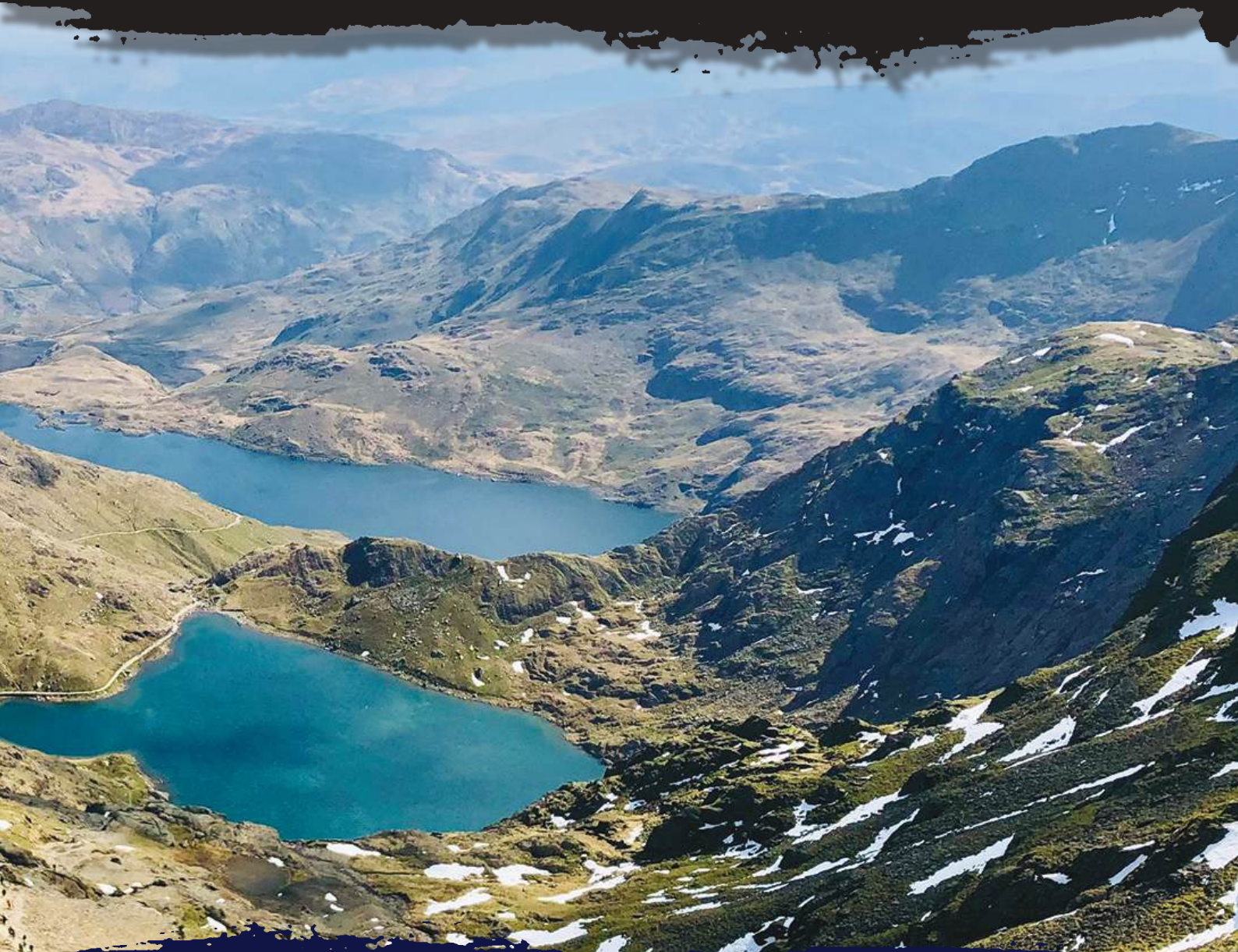

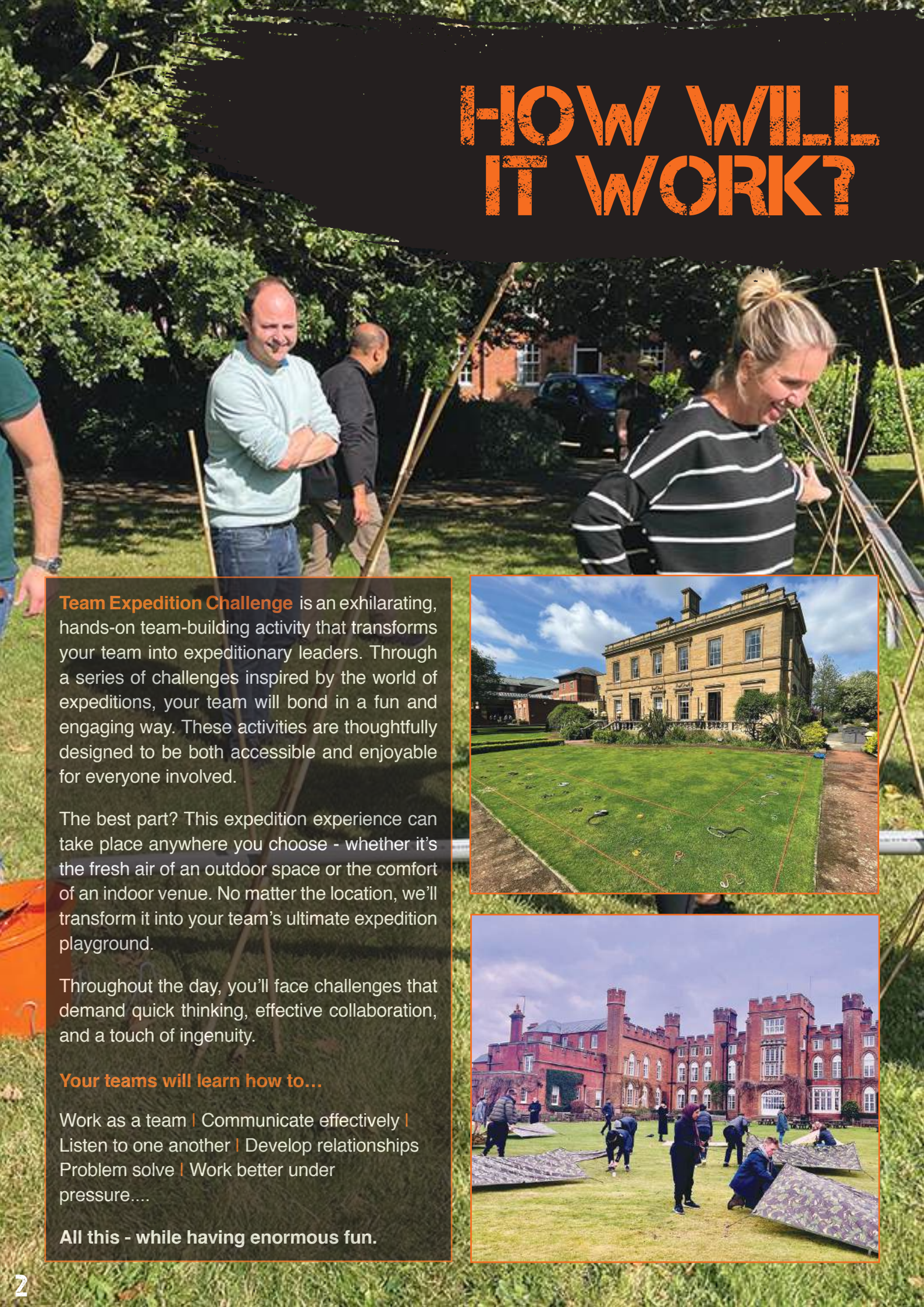

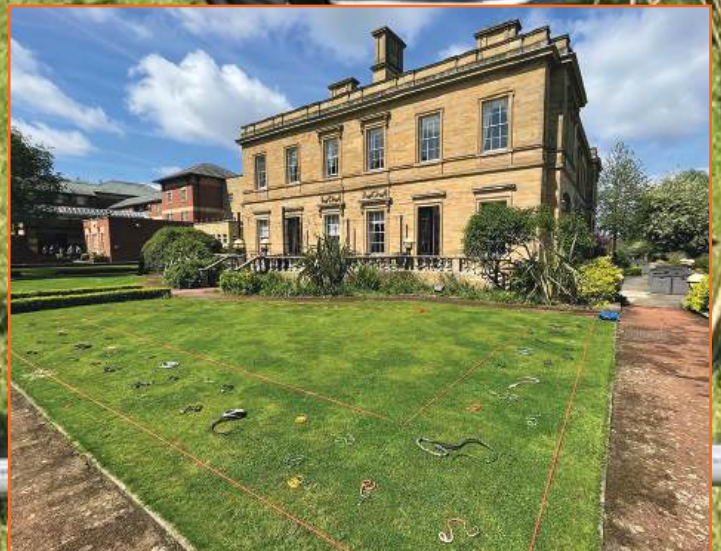

Participants will be divided into evenly-sized teams and will rotate through challenge zones, completing each activity in turn. Expedition Dollars will be awarded for each successfully completed task. By the end of the day, the team with the highest total will be crowned the Expedition Champions.

INDOOR CHALLENGES

1. Suitcase Survival Challenge - Practical table-based challenge

The team finds themselves stranded in the wilderness after a plane crash. As they sift through the scattered luggage, they must prioritise items, assessing their importance for survival. Failure to make strategic choices could mean being lost forever.

2. Signal Tower - Practical table based challenge

Under pressure and with limited resources, the team must strategise and collaborate to construct an improvised tower. The team that builds the tallest and most stable structure emerges victorious.

3. Morse Code Challenge - Paper based challenge

The team must decode Morse code signals sent by an injured mountaineer in distress. Using the information received, they must work together to plot a precise rescue plan on a map, ensuring a swift and effective response to save the stranded climber.

4. Memory Map - Practical table based challenge

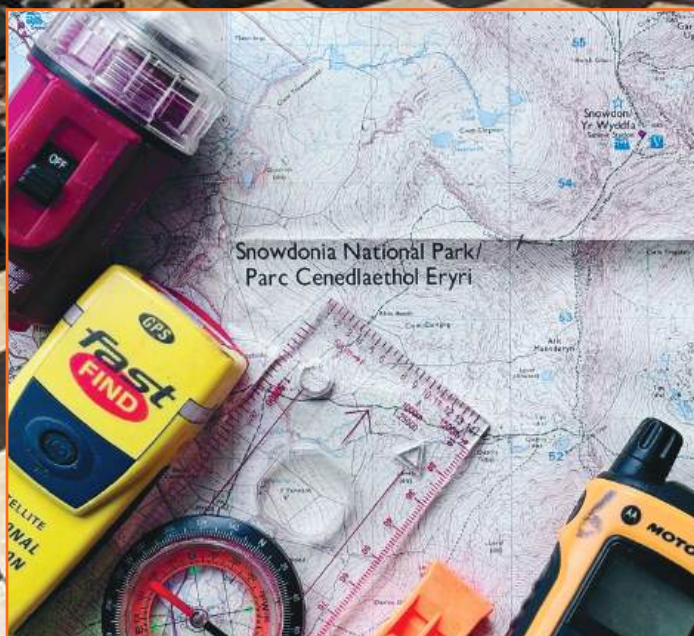
After being briefly shown an aerial map of an island, the team must rely on their memory to recreate the map, capturing key details and landmarks from what they observed.

5. Expedition Meal Plan - Paper based challenge

The team must carefully plan a week's worth of expedition meals, ensuring they meet the required calorie intake while staying within the weight limits for the insertion plane flight.

6. Radio Communication Challenge - Practical challenge

Effective communication is crucial for successful expeditions. In this challenge, the team will be split and positioned out of sight from one another. Using radios as their sole means of contact, participants must relay clear and precise instructions to ensure the successful completion of the task at hand.



OUTDOOR CHALLENGES

7. Snake Pit Challenge - Practical challenge
Blindfolded team members must carefully navigate a winding path littered with harmless rubber snakes. The catch? They'll rely entirely on the voices and directions of their teammates to guide them to safety.

8. Water Source Challenge - Practical challenge
The team's task is to design and construct a free-standing structure using materials such as bamboo, bungee cord, and guttering. Their mission? To successfully get water to flow from point A to point B.

9. Expedition Retrieval Challenge - Practical challenge
The team must work together to retrieve essential expedition items using a system of ropes, hooks, and pulleys.

10. Blindfolded Rescue Knot Challenge - Practical challenge
Team individuals must master an emergency rescue knot to ensure they can be pulled to safety. Sounds simple? Here's the twist: they'll need to do it blindfolded!

11. Emergency Shelter Challenge - Practical challenge
The team must race against the clock to construct emergency shelters before the arrival of an impending storm.
